(5th) SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS this Commission by an order dated July 18, 1914 (Decision No. 1675), authorized SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA to issue \$240,500.00 face value of Six Per Cent Three Year Notes, said notes to be issued at not less than 93 per cent of the face value, and

WHEREAS this Commission's order dated July 18, 1914, as amended, expired on June 30, 1915, and

WHEREAS applicant in a supplemental application filed September 13, 1915, reports that notes in the principal sum of \$90,500.00 heretofore authorized remain unsold and are now held in escrow by the Central Trust Company of Illinois, Chicago, Illinois, subject to an agreement with the purchasers of the \$150,000.00 face value of notes, and

WHEREAS, applicant asks this Commission to extend the time within which it may sell its said 3-year notes heretofore authorized to and including April 1, 1916, in order that it may sell the \$90,500.00 face value of notes

now held in escrow with the Central Trust Company of Illinois, or any portion of the same, from time to time without further application before the Railroad Commission of the State of California upon the company making the proper showing in accordance with the agreement and satisfactory to the trustees of the notes, and


WHEREAS a public hearing has been held and it appearing to this Commission that applicant's request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order of this Commission dated July 18, 1914, (Decision No. 1675) be amended to the end that the authority therein granted to the applicant to issue 3-year notes in the sum of \$240,500.00 shall apply to such notes as shall have been issued on or before April 1, 1916.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Commission's order dated July 18, 1914 (Decision No. 1675), and any supplemental orders modifying or amending said order of July 18, 1914, shall remain in full force and effect, except as the same may be amended or modified by this supplemental order.

The foregoing Supplemental Order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the Supplemental Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
