## THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing:

It is hereby ordered that Section 1, paragraph "b" of this Commission's Order of July 23, 1913, (Decision No. 808) in the above entitled matter, be and is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

and sell its common capital stock of the par value of not to exceed \$138,890.00 so as to net said company not less than 90 per cent in cash of the par value thereof, and may apply the proceeds only for the purpose of constructing and completing its proposed six-story and basement steel frame concrete warehouse building, to be erected on said lot No. 2 in the block bounded by R; S; Eleventh and Twelfth Streets, in the City of Sacramento, and also for

the payment of the necessary organization and office expenses, including the General Manager's salary to June 15, 1915, said organization and office expenses, including General Manager's salary to June 15, 1915, not to exceed the sum of \$8,797.13."

IT IS EEREBY FURTHER CRDERED that this Commission's Order dated July 23, 1913, (Decision No. 808) and the Supplemental Orders amending the same, shall remain in full force and effect except as the same are modified by this Third Supplemental Order.
