ORDER OF DISMISSAL

BY THE COMMISSION:

Under date of October 20, 1915, the Commission is advised by applicant herein that as the Interstate Commerce Commission has not yet rendered the decision on the rehearing of Rule 20 of Western Classification No. 55, which relates to this same subject, the hearing upon said application for rehearing having been held on July 30, 1915 at Chicago, and as this application provides for permission to cancel the rule of the Exception Sheet permitting Rule 20 of the Western Classification to apply after the date of such cancellation, no progress can be made until it is known whether the Interstate Commerce Commission, in the decision to be rendered on the rehearing of Rule 20, will order any change made in that rule, in consequence of which applicant requests that this application be dismissed. In view of this request, which the Commission considers a reasonable one,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application No. 1852 be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.
