John P. Coghlan, as Receiver of the properties  
of Northern Electric Railway Company, Sacramento and  
Woodland Railroad Company, Northern Electric Railway  
Company--Marysville and Colusa Branch, and Sacramento  
Terminal Company having filed his petition asking that  
the Railroad Commission make its order authorizing him  
to require or permit engineers, conductors, brakemen  
and other trainmen on the railroads operated by him  
and hereinbefore mentioned, to receive, deliver and  
transmit by telephone, orders for the movement of trains,  
cars, engines and motors upon, over and along said rail-  
roads, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion  
that said request is reasonable and should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be, and  
the same is hereby, granted and that John P. Coghlan be, and

he hereby is, authorized to require or permit any of the engineers, conductors, brakemen or other trainmen on the railroads operated by him and hereinbefore mentioned, to receive, deliver and transmit by telephone, orders for the movement of trains, cars, engines and motors upon, over and along said railroads as and when the same may be necessary.
