O P I N I O N

This complaint was filed with the Commission on July 2, 1915, by certain residents of Cottage Grove, a sub-division suburban to the City of San Jose. Subsequently, Geo. W. Robinson, manager of Cottage Grove Water Company, filed application No. 1776 before the Commission for an increase in rates for water served in Cottage Grove.

These two matters were consolidated at the hearing held on September 21, 1915. Inasmuch as the

rates and service are so closely related in these two actions and certain matters complained of no longer exist, the Commission will cover the issues of the complaint in its decision and order on the rate Application No. 1776, reference to which is hereby made, and order that the present action be dismissed without prejudice to complainants.

O R D E R

Cottage Grove Consumers Organization having made complaint as to the service and equipment of the Cottage Grove Water Company, and a hearing having been held and it appearing that the matters complained are remedied in part and any complaints remaining being fully considered in the decision and opinion of this Commission in Application No. 1776, heard jointly with the case herewith, to which reference is hereby made.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this complaint be dismissed without prejudice.
