ity to abandon and remove its railroad track

from Olive Avenue east; on Esperanza Avenue  
from Third Street to Ocean Avenue; and on  
Ocean Avenue from American Avenue to Miramar  
Avenue, and to construct and operate, at grade,  
in lieu thereof, a railroad on Olive Avenue  
from Third Street to Broadway, thence easter-  
ly on Broadway over and along the Southern  
Pacific tracks to and across Alamitos Avenue  
to a connection with petitioner's Third  
Street line in said City.
