SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Representation having been made to the Railroad Commission that doubt exists concerning the meaning of the second proviso of this Commission's order of December 11, 1915, in the above entitled proceedings, which proviso reads as follows:

"2. United Railroads of San Francisco and Market Street Railway Company shall not issue the notes and bonds herein referred to until the Railroad Commission has made a supplemental order reciting that United Railroads of San Francisco has produced its original books of account for the years 1907, 1908, 1909, 1910 and 1911, or that United Railroads of San Francisco has taken and is taking the necessary steps, legal and otherwise, to secure the return to its possession of said books."

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said proviso be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2. United Railroads of San Francisco and Market Street Railway Company shall not issue the notes and bonds herein referred to until the Railroad Commission has made a supplemental order reciting that United Railroads of San Francisco has produced its original books of account for the years 1907, 1908, 1909, 1910 and 1911, or that United Railroads of San Francisco has taken and is taking all reasonable steps, by legal process or otherwise, to secure the return to its possession of said books."

In all other respects said order of December 11, 1915,
shall remain in full force and effect.
