The Pacific Electric Railway Company having made application to this Commission for its approval of the relocation of two switch leads from its main line tracks on Hill Street, Los Angeles, same serving its Hill Street Station and the relocation being necessary in connection with a rearrangement of terminal facilities at the aforesaid Hill Street Station, a plan of the proposed relocation having been submitted as Exhibit "A" in the above numbered application and the Commission being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary in this proceeding;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the Pacific Electric Railway Company be and the same hereby is authorized to relocate the switch leads from its main line tracks on Hill Street, Los Angeles, same serving the passenger terminal facilities at Hill Street Station and in accordance with map numbered "MWA 562" dated February 25, 1916 and filed as Applicant's Exhibit "A" in the above entitled proceeding.
