In the matter of the application of BOARD OF TRUSTEES, City of Colton, San Bernardino County, California, for permission to construct 8th Street at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Company.

ORDER

By the Commission.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES of City of Colton, San Bernardino County, California, having on November 4, filed with the Commission its application for permission to construct 8th Street at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Company in said City of Colton, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that Southern Pacific Company has executed an easement to said city, granting the right to construct said street at grade across its tracks, and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossings of said street with said tracks and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted to Board of Trustees, City of Colton, San Bernardino County, California, to extend 8th Street of said city at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Company between "J" Street and "K" Street, as shown by the map attached to the application, provided that the crossings are constructed and hereafter maintained in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public and properly protected by crossing gates.

The Commission reserves the right to hereafter make such further orders relative to the construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings as to it may seem right and proper, and

to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
