In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a corporation, for an order authorizing the extension of a passing track at grade across a public highway called Ellis Lane in the Town of Savanna, Los Angeles County, California.

ORDER

By the Commission.

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a corporation, having on November 5, 1912, filed with the Commission its application for permission to extend its present passing track across Ellis Lane, a public highway, in the Town of Savanna, Los Angeles County, California, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossing with said public highway, and that the application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted Southern Pacific Company to extend its passing track at grade across a public highway known as Ellis Lane in the Town of Savanna, Los Angeles County, California, as shown by the map attached to the application, subject to the following conditions:

(1) The entire expense of constructing the crossing together with its maintenance hereafter in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by applicant.

(2) Applicant shall provide at its own expense the necessary plank or guard rails for said crossing and shall ballast same, including the approaches thereto, to a depth of not less than six (6) inches with first-class gravel or stone ballast.

(3) The crossing shall be made of a width not less than eighteen (18) feet and with grades of approach not exceeding eight (8) percent.

(4) The Commission reserves the right to hereafter make such further orders relative to the construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
