This is an application on behalf of the Southern Pacific Company for permission to discontinue the maintenance of an agent at its station of Barber in Butte County on the Sacramento Division for the reason that the said station of Barber is located within the yard limits of the station of Chico and all business heretofore transacted with the agency station of Barber can hereafter be handled satisfactorily and conveniently through the agency station of Chico. The Commission is of the opinion that this is not an application in which a public hearing is necessary.
