BY THE COMMISSION:

The applicant, Colorado River Telephone Company, having applied to this Commission for authority to construct and operate a telephone system in certain portions of Riverside County, California, Application No. 2031, and said application having been granted by the Commission upon condition that said applicant should purchase a certain telephone line heretofore constructed and in operation in and in the vicinity of the town of Blythe and Blythe Junction, Riverside County, under terms and conditions which shall be approved by this Commission, and said applicant, Colorado River Telephone Company, having with Mrs. Jessie Brown filed a joint application with this Commission for authority to complete the sale and transfer for the sum of \$1,250.00, and it having been stipulated by the parties at the hearing in Application No. 2031 in the City of Riverside on February 29, 1916, that the testimony introduced at that hearing shall be considered in evidence in the within application (Application No. 2162) and no reasonable objection appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be and it is hereby granted, provided that the price to be paid for the sale and transfer of this telephone line shall not be taken by this

Commission or other authority as representing the value of this property for rate making or other purposes.
