It is hereby declared that on June 16, 1916, San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric Company filed herein a stipulation, duly authorized by its board of directors, and in form satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, declaring that San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric Company, its successors and assigns, will never claim before the Railroad Commission or any court or other public body, any value for the franchises and permits of Oceanside Electric and Gas Company in excess of the actual cost of acquiring said franchises and permits, which cost is reported by San Diego Consolidated Gas and Electric Company to have been the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
