SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, Napa City Water Company was on the 24th day of May, 1916 by Decision No. 3373 granted authority to sell \$2500.00 face value of its 5 per cent. treasury bonds at par and to apply the proceeds thereof as set forth in said order, which authorized among other matters the purchase and installation of a deep well turbine pump at a cost of \$832.50, and

WHEREAS, applicant now finds after having installed and later removed said pump, at a cost of \$150.00, that owing to the presence of gases it is impracticable to use a turbine pump in said well and that in order to obtain the necessary water supply it will, in applicant's opinion, be necessary to bore and equip another well at its plant known as Pumping Station No. 2, and

WHEREAS, Napa City Water Company has filed a supplemental application with this Commission requesting permission to issue at par two more of its treasury bonds of the face value of \$500.00 each and to apply the proceeds of said issue to the boring and equipment of said new well, together with

\$682.50 of the sum authorized in Decision No. 3373 to be applied upon the purchase and installation of a deep well turbine pump,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Napa City Water Company be and the same is hereby authorized to issue at par, subject to the conditions set forth in Decision No. 3373, two of its 5 per cent. treasury bonds of the face value of \$500.00 each, in addition to the five bonds authorized to be issued under said decision;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant be authorized to apply the proceeds of said bonds and \$682.50 of the proceeds of the bonds authorized to be issued under Decision No. 3373 substantially as follows:

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all the provisions of this Commission's order in the above entitled matter, dated May 24, 1916 (Decision No. 3373), shall remain in full force and effect except as modified or amended by this order.
