THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission having on February 25, 1916, made an order approving a certain lease described in said order and under the terms of which The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company agrees that it will for a period of thirty days, beginning February 22, 1916, operate the line of railroad owned by Laton and Western Railroad Company under certain conditions specified in the agreement, and applicants having asked for the approval of the Commission to an extension of the term of said lease to and including Saturday, August 26, 1916, and it appearing to the Commission that such request is reasonable and should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Commission give its approval to an extension to and including Saturday, August 26, 1916, of the term of the lease of the line of Laton and Western Railroad Company by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company referred to above.
