ORDER

By the Commission.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES, Stanislaus County, California, having on November 15, 1912, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct a public highway at grade across the track of Southern Pacific Company, same being an extension of Julian Street, City of Turlock, Stanislaus County, California, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that Southern Pacific Company has entered into an agreement dated November 18, 1912, with applicant, a copy of which is now filed in connection with the application, granting the right to applicant to open said public highway known as Julian Street across its track in said city, and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said track and that the application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted BOARD OF TRUSTEES, City of Turlock, Stanislaus County, California, to construct a public highway known as Julian Street across the track of Southern Pacific Company between First Street and Modesto Road at engineer's station 1720+85, as shown by the map attached to the application, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The entire expense of constructing the crossing together with the cost of its maintenance hereafter up to within two
