O R D E R.

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and San Diego and Arizona Railway Company having applied to this Commission for approval of a certain agreement entered into between said companies; a copy of said agreement is attached to the application herein and marked Exhibit "A", and under the terms of which the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company are permitted to operate jointly with the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company certain tracks in the City of San Diego from a connection at or near the intersection of 9th and "N" Streets, San Diego to the passenger station of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and to a point at or near the intersection of Beech and California Streets, San Diego; also to use jointly the passenger station facilities of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. It appearing to the Commission that the approval of this agreement will be beneficial to the public and facilitate the business of the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company and

that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary,
and that the application should be granted,
