This is an application of Southern

California Gas Company for authority to renew for a period not exceeding one year from their respective dates of maturity promissory notes in the total sum of \$49,787.90.

The notes which applicant desires to renew

Witness for applicant stated that of the above notes, those issued to Sprague Meter Company and J. G. White Engineering Corporation represent notes issued directly for capital expenditures.

William G. Kerckhoff and Kespare Cohn Commercial and
Savings Bank represent advances made by said parties and
used either for additions and betterments or to reimburse
applicant's treasury for capital expenditures made out
of income. Witness also stated that the note to Merchants
National Bank of Los Angeles was given by the Company in
order to take up a note given by a wholesale consumer
in payment for gas purchased. This consumer went into
bankruptcy and the Company found it necessary to give its
own note for the purpose of securing possession of the
note given by the consumer.

After a consideration of the evidence submitted by applicant I am of the opinion that this application should be granted and accordingly submit the following form of Order:

ORDER

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY having applied to this Commission for authority to issue \$49,787.90 face value of promissory notes for the purpose of renewing other notes now outstanding as hereinbefore set forth;

And a hearing having been held;

And it appearing to this Commission that applicant's request is reasonable and should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California
Gas Company be and it is hereby authorized to issue its
promissory notes for a term not exceeding one year for the
purpose of renewing the following promissory notes now outstanding

The authority herein granted is granted upon the following conditions and not otherwise:

l.-The notes herein authorized to be issued shall be issued so as to net applicant not less than the face value thereof.

2.-The notes herein authorized to be issued shall be issued to the same payers, at the same rates of interest and in the same amounts as the notes which they are given to refund.

3.-Applicant may, if it so desires, issue notes for a period of less than I year and renew said notes from time to time, provided that the combined terms of the notes herein authorized and those issued in renewal thereof shall not exceed I year.

4.—Southern California Gas Company shall report to the Railroad Commission within ten days after the issue of the respective notes hereby authorized the fact and the date of issue, the face value of the respective notes, the rate of interest and the application of the proceeds, all in accordance with this Commission's General Order No. 24, which order in so far as applicable is made a part of this order.

5.-The authority herein granted is conditioned upon the payment by applicant of the fee prescribed in the Public Utilities Act as amended.

6.-The authority herein granted shall apply only to notes issued on or before August 31, 1917.

The foregoing Opinion and Order are hereby approved and ordered filed as the Opinion and Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
