BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY having in this proceeding asked permission to discontinue the agency now maintained at the station of Nelson in Butte County, on its Sacramento division, and a hearing having been held and the Commission having on June 28, 1915, made an order directing the Company to make and keep an accurate, detailed account of the freight and passenger business transacted at said station and of the expense of maintenance of an agent at said station for a period of one year from the effective date of said order, for the purpose of determining whether there is justification for the discontinuance of this station, and Southern Pacific Company having on August 2, 1916, advised the Commission that the Company no longer desires to discontinue this station, and it appearing that accordingly it is not necessary for the Company to keep account of the passenger and freight business and of the expense of maintaining an agent at said station, as directed by said order of the Commission,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order of the Commission heretofore made by this Commission on June 28, 1915 be, and the same is hereby set aside, and that this application be, and the same is hereby denied.
