This is an application by Pacific Gas & Electric Company, a corporation, for an order approving a certain agreement entered into by said corporation with George A. Van Smith and J. C. Eller, by the terms of which said corporation proposes to extend its distributing line to the premises of said Van Smith and said Eller in order to supply them with electricity for lighting purposes. In consideration therefor said Van Smith and said Eller each guarantee said corporation that he will ^{pay for} ~~pay~~ a certain annual minimum of electric energy.

The contract appears to us, under the circumstances of this particular case, to be entirely fair both from the point of view of the public service company

and of the consumers, and we are of the opinion that the application should be granted.




O R D E R.

PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY having applied to this Commission for approval of a certain agreement entered into by and between it and George A. Van Smith and J. C. Eller, and a public hearing having been held, and it appearing to this Commission that for the reason set forth in the foregoing opinion the contract should be authorized,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas & Electric Company be and the same is hereby authorized to enter into a certain contract for the service of electricity to George A. Van Smith and J. C. Eller in form and substance substantially as set forth in the instrument designated as "Exhibit A", annexed to the application in the above entitled matter.

The authority herein granted is granted subject to the condition that applicant shall file with this Commission two copies of the contract herein authorized, within sixty (60) days of the date of this order.
