engaged in supplying water to about 750 persons in the territory in the city of Los Angeles, bounded on the north by Stephenson Avenue; on the east by the City boundary; on the south by the City boundary, and on the west by Spence street, having applied to this Commission for authority to sell to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a form of deed attached to the application and marked "Exhibit B," the following described property:

- (a) All water pipes, service connections, meters, appliances, appurtenances and extensions constituting and pertaining to the water distributing system known as the water works of the Hollenbeck Heights Company and supplying water in the territory lying inside the City of Los Angeles, and bounded as follows: On the North by Stephenson Avenue: on the East by the City Boundary: on the South by the City Boundary and on the Test by Spence Street; together with all mains, connections and appurtenances pertaining to said water system within the district above named, or elsewhere in said City; and all water mains and service connections, extensions and appurtenances thereof, owned, used and operated by said first party for supplying water in said City; excepting wells, pumps, machinery, buildings and the land whereon the same are located;
- (b) All franchises and rights of way owned or held by or for said first party and used or necessary in connection with the construction of said works:
- (c) All maps and records pertaining to said water system and relating to pipes, services, consumers, property ratings, etc.

And the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles having joined in the application, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be, and the same is hereby granted.
