FIFTEENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS this Commission by Decision Number 2726, dated August 31, 1915, (Vol. 7, Opinions and Orders of the Railroad Commission of California, page 923) authorized the delivery to Western States Gas and Electric Company of \$182,000.00 face value of bonds, the issue of which was authorized by Decision Number 2150, dated June 30, 1915, (Vol. 7, Opinions and Orders of the Railroad Commission of California, page 485) provided that Western States Gas and Electric Company deposit with the trustee, Girard Trust Company, the sum of \$182,000.00 in cash, said \$182,000.00 so deposited with the trustee to be withdrawn by the applicant from time to time in accordance with the order of this Commission permitting the withdrawal, and

WHEREAS applicant has heretofore reported the cost of extensions, additions and betterments at \$223,606.36, and

WHEREAS applicant reports that under its deed of trust it can issue bonds only to pay for 75 per cent of the cost of extensions, additions and betterments, and

WHEREAS applicant reports in a statement filed August 18, 1916, that it has expended from July 1, 1916 to July 31, 1916,

both dates inclusive, the sum of \$17,129.69 for extensions, additions and betterments to its plant, and

WHEREAS applicant asks authority to withdraw from the aforesaid fund remaining on deposit with the trustee the sum of \$12,847.27, representing 75 per cent of the cost of extensions, additions and betterments installed during the month of July, 1916,

And Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western States Gas and Electric Company be given authority, and it is hereby given authority, to withdraw from Girard Trust Company the sum of \$12,847.27, being a portion of the amount deposited with the trustee in accordance with Decision No. 2726, dated August 31, 1915 of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 2150, dated June 30, 1915, as amended by the supplemental orders thereto, shall remain in full force and effect except as it may be modified by this fifteen supplemental order.
