DECISION

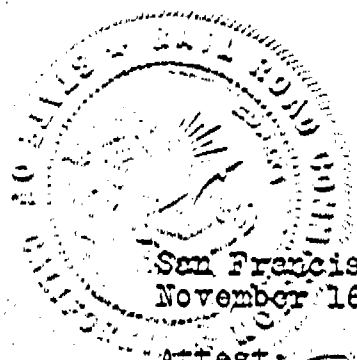
This is an application on the part of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company to cancel rate of 7½ cents per thousand shingles, including wharfage and handling, from Ferry Point Richmond to Stockton, which rate was established as a yarding-in-transit arrangement for a shingle-drying concern at Stockton, which institution has since gone out of business. The necessity for maintaining this rate, therefore, no longer exists and permission to cancel the same is hereby granted.
