ORDER.

CRESCENT CITY LIGHT, WATER AND POWER COMPANY  
having applied to this Commission for authority to sell  
to J. M. Hotchkiss for the sum of twenty-one hundred dol-  
lars (\$2100.00) in cash, and the release and satisfaction  
of a certain claim of the Hobbs-Wall & Company against  
said Crescent City Light, Water and Power Company amount-  
ing to twenty-nine hundred and twenty-two dollars (\$2922.00)  
with interest at the rate of 7% per annum from the 8th day  
of October, 1913, in accordance with the form of deed at-  
tached to the application in this proceeding and marked  
"Exhibit A," the following described property, to-wit:

Being the block of land bounded by "E" street,  
Ninth Street, "F" Street and Tenth Street of said  
City, together with all buildings and fixtures on  
said premises, and the following described person-  
al property, to-wit:

And J. M. Hotchkiss having joined in this application and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application in this proceeding be, and the same is hereby, granted upon the following conditions, and not otherwise, to-wit:

1. The consideration paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall not be taken before this Commission, or any other public body for rate-fixing or other pur-

poses, as being the actual value of the  
property transferred;

2. The authority herein granted to transfer  
property shall be effective only up to  
and including September 30, 1916.
