In the matter of the application of SAN DIEGO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, for permission to construct Tamarack Avenue at grade across the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka, and Sante Fe Railway Company near Carlsbad, San Diego County, California.

SAN DIEGO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, having on August 21, 1916, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct Tamarack Avenue at grade across the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka, and Sante Fe Railway Company near Carlsbad, San Diego County, California, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the necessary permission has been granted by The Atchison, Topeka, and Sante Fe Railway Company for the construction of said crossing at grade, and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with the tracks of The said Atchison, Topeka, and Sante Fe Railway Company, and that this application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be hereby granted San Diego County, California, to construct Tamarack Avenue at grade across the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka, and Sante Fe Railway Company near Carlsbad, San Diego County, California, as shown by the map attached to the application; said crossing to be constructed subject to the following conditions, viz:

- (1) The entire expense of constructing the crossing in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by applicant.
- (2) The expense of maintaining it thereafter shall be
