BY THE COMMISSION.

O R D E R

HOLLYWOOD WATER COMPANY having applied to  
this Commission for authority to convey to Union Holly-  
wood Water Company, for the sum of Thirty Thousand  
(\$30,000.) Dollars, the following described property:

"The entire water system of the said  
Hollywood Water Company situate in the City  
of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State  
of California, and supplying water chiefly  
but not exclusively in the following describ-  
ed territory in said city, to wit: Bounded  
on the north by Sunset Boulevard; on the  
east by Vermont Avenue; on the south by Tem-  
ple Street and on the West by Gower Street;  
together with all water pipes and mains, ser-  
vice connections, meters, fittings, appliances,  
appurtenances and extensions constituting and  
pertaining to the said system and also all  
maps, records and personal property of every  
kind connected with said system and owned by  
the said Hollywood Water Company; also all  
franchises and rights of way owned or held by

said Hollywood Water Company and used or necessary to be used in connection with the operation of the said system."

And Union Hollywood Water Company having joined in the application, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be, and the same hereby is, granted.
