O R D E R.

The Southern Pacific Company having made application to this Commission for an order authorizing the change of location of its station of Harold on the San Joaquin Division to a point approximately one-half mile easterly of its present location, such change rendered necessary by reason of track relocation permitting the construction of a reservoir for irrigating purposes; an inspection having been made and the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is a case in which a public hearing is unnecessary and that the application should be granted,
