ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The San Gabriel Valley Water Company filed application as above entitled on May 6, 1916, requesting the approval of the Commission for a schedule of rules and regulations, which schedule involved some minor modification of the rates recently established by order of this Commission.

Subsequent to this filing, various of the provisions in this schedule were discussed informally with the management of the utility company and various consumers and a tentative agreement reached in those particulars. The other provisions of the schedule were found by the Commission to be in conformity with all precedents that had been set by the Commission.

Thereupon, the schedule, as revised, was accepted for filing by the Commission and formal action is, therefore, unnecessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application No. 2262 be and the same is hereby dismissed.
