BEFORE THE RAILROAD CONMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the application of RIVERSIDE COUNTY GAS AND POWER CPMPANY to purchase and of BEAUMONT GAS AND POWER COMPANY and of THE BANNING GAS AND LIGHTING COMPANY to sell the properties of the last-named companies; of RIVERSIDE COUNTY GAS AND POWER COMPANY to issue stocks and bonds and for a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

This Commission having, on October 2, 1916, made an order in this proceeding, containing, among other things, the following:

"The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby declares that public convenience and necessity require the exercise by Riverside County Gas and Power: Company of the rights and privi-leges conferred upon Beaumont Gas and Power Company by Ordinance No. 97 of Riverside County, adopted January 3,1910, and upon the Banning Gas and Lighting Company by Ordinance No. 91 of Riverside County, adopted April 15th, 1908, provided that Riverside County Gas and Power Company shall first have filed with the Railroad Commission a stipulation duly authorized by its Board of Directors, declaring that Riverside County Gas and Power Company, its successors and assigns, will never claim before the Railroad Commission or any court or other public body, a value for said rights and privileges in excess of the actual cost to Riverside County Gas and Power Company of acquiring said rights and privileges, which cost is represented by Riverside County Gas and Power Company to have been not in excess of \$100, and shall have received from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order declaring that

such stipulation, in form satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, has been filed with the Railroad Commission, "

and Riverside County Gas and Power Company having, on November 9, 1916, filed with the Railroad Commission a stipulation as required by said Order in form satisfactory to the Railroad Commission:

IT IS HERREY ORDERED that the form of said stipulation be, and the same is, hereby approved.
