SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

This Commission having heretofore, on July 20, 1912, made an order in the above proceeding authorizing Peoples Water Company to issue promissory notes to the aggregate amount of Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) Dollars, and to issue and pledge as security for the payment of these promissory notes Peoples Water Company general mortgage, five per cent, thirty year, gold bonds to the aggregate amount of One Million Five-hundred Thousand (\$1,500,000) Dollars, upon certain conditions specified in said order, one of which conditions was that the authority therein granted should apply only to notes and bonds issued by Peoples Water Company on or before the 30th day of October, 1912, which date was extended by this Commission in a supplemental order made on October 18, 1912, to and including the 28th day of January, 1913; and

Peoples Water Company having on December 18, 1912, filed with this Commission a second supplemental application requesting that the time limit placed upon the authority granted in this Commission's order in the above entitled proceeding, made on July 20, 1912, be further extended to and including the 28th day of April, 1913; and

This Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and also that there is no objection to the granting of this second supplemental appli-

cation,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the time limit placed upon the authority granted in this Commission's order made in the above proceeding on July 20, 1912, be and the same hereby is extended from the 28th day of January, 1913, to and including the 28th day of April, 1913.
