SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing therefor, it is hereby ordered that the first paragraph of the order in the original decision in the above entitled matter (Decision No. 4183, dated March 16, 1917) be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"Western States Gas and Electric Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to create a 10-year 6 per cent note indebtedness of the face value of \$5,000,000, and to issue \$1,564,000 of notes at not less than 92 per cent of their face value and to execute a trust agreement securing said issue, and a public hearing having been held and the Commission finding that the money, property, or labor to be procured or paid for by such issue is reasonably required for the purposes hereinafter specified in this order, and that such purposes are not in whole or in part reasonably

chargeable to operating expenses or to income, and that for the reasons set forth in the foregoing opinion the application should be granted, subject to the conditions and modifications hereinafter set forth."

It is hereby further ordered that all the provisions of this Commission's order in the above entitled matter dated March 16, 1917 (Decision No. 4183) shall remain in full force and effect except as modified or amended by this order.
