ORDER

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a corporation, having on May 18, 1917, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct a spur track at grade across Depot Street in the Town of Morganhill, Santa Clara County, California, as hereinafter indicated; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the necessary franchise or permit has been granted by the Town of Morganhill for the construction of said crossing at grade; and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said Depot Street, and that this application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be hereby granted Southern Pacific Company to construct a spur track at grade across Depot Street in the Town of Morganhill, Santa Clara County, California, described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the northeasterly line of Depot Street, distant 160 feet northwesterly from the intersection of said line of Depot Street and the northwesterly line of Fifth Street, produced northeasterly; thence northwesterly and across said Depot Street, 190 feet and entering private property."
