SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

road Commission or any court or other public body a value
for the rights and privileges conferred by Ordinance No. 32
of the City of Beverly Hills in excess of the original cost
of acquiring said rights and privileges, which cost is rep-
resented to be \$500.00.--
