ment was included in the order therein that California Telephone and
Light Company "prepare and file with the Railroad Commission on or
before July 10, 1917 rules and regulations for the service of elec-
tricity in its territory which shall be acceptable to the Commis-
sion", and it now appearing, for good cause shown, that it will be
impossible for California Telephone and Light Company to comply with

this requirement within the time limit stated,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which California Telephone and Light Company shall prepare and file its rules and regulations in compliance with the Commission's order in Decision 4438 shall be and the same is hereby extended until the 25th day of July 1917.
