FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES

that Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation has filed with the Railroad Commission a stipulation, duly authorized by its Board of Directors, in form satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, agreeing for itself, its successors and assigns, that it will never claim before the Railroad Commission or any other public authority any value for the rights and privileges conferred by Ordinance No. 467, N.S. of the County of Los Angeles, adopted April 2, 1917 ~~July 28, 1912~~, in excess of the amount paid therefor by the grantee of the franchise, which amount is declared in said stipulation to have been the sum of \$232.70.
