ORDER.

transfer to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles, for the sum of \$2,500.00, the public utility water system supplying approximately 123 persons in that portion of the City of Los Angeles lying to the east of Huntington Drive in the Navarro Tract, and Huntington Boulevard Tract in the City of Los Angeles, the conveyance to be made in accordance with the form of deed attached to the application and marked "Exhibit B," describing the property to be transferred as follows:

All water pipes, service connections, fittings, meters, appliances, appurtenances and extensions, constituting and pertaining to the water distributing system owned by the Sierra Park Company, and used and operated by said Sierra Park Company for supplying water in the territory within The City of Los Angeles lying to the east of Huntington Drive, and approximately one-fourth (2) of a mile north of Bairdstown, in those certain tracts known as the Navarro Tract and the Huntington Boulevard Tract in said City.

RIGHTS OF WAY

All franchises and rights of way owned or held by or for said Sierra Park Company, and used or necessary in connection with the construction or operation of said works, or any part thereof, or any extension of said works.

MAPS AND RECOPDS, ETC.

All maps and records pertaining to said water system, and relating to pipes, services, consumers, property, rates, etc.

And the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles having joined in the application, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said application be, and the same hereby is granted.
