SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sierra and San Francisco Power Company be and it is hereby authorized to use \$80,000.00 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of \$1,000,000.00 face value of First Mortgage Five Per Cent Forty Year Gold Bonds authorized by Decision Number 3816, dated October 24, 1916, to reimburse its treasury in the sum of \$30,000.00 and to pay The Washington Water Power Company \$50,000.00, said sums representing payments made or to be made under a contract for the purchase of a 9,000 kilowatt turbine and auxiliaries entered into between Sierra and San Francisco Power Company and The Washington Water Power Company on or about the 8th. day of May, 1917.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED THAT this Commission's Decision Number 3816, dated October 24, 1916, as amended by the supplemental orders of the Railroad Commission shall remain in full force and effect except as amended by this Sixth Supplemental Order.
