IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that in accordance with the  
order heretofore made in this proceeding on August 1, 1917,  
The Tulare Home Telephone and Telegraph Company has filed a

signs will claim before the Railroad Commission or any Court  
or other public body a value for the rights and privileges  
granted in ordinances No. CLXXVII and CXLIV of the City of  
Tulare in addition to the actual cost thereof, which cost is  
stated to be \$50.00 for each of said two franchises.
