ORDER.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles hav-  
ing, in Ordinance No. 315, N.S., adopted on October 7, 1912, granted  
to George H. Bixby a franchise to lay, construct, maintain and ope-  
rate a gas distributing system under, along and across certain  
streets, alleys and public places in the County of Los Angeles, and  
said George H. Bixby having applied to this Commission for an order  
authorizing him to transfer said franchise to Long Beach Consolidated  
Gas Company and Long Beach Consolidated Gas Company having joined in  
said application, and it appearing to the Commission that public con-  
venience and necessity will be subserved by the transfer of said fran-  
chise, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case  
in which a public hearing is necessary,
