SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the order in Decision number 4369, dated June 2, 1917, authorizes applicant in the above entitled matter to issue and sell \$70,000 of bonds at not less than 95 per cent of their face value plus accrued interest and use the proceeds to pay floating indebtedness incurred for proper capital purposes, provided that before issuing any of the \$70,000 of bonds, applicant shall have filed with the Railroad Commission a statement of the floating indebtedness which it proposes to pay out of the proceeds of such bonds; and

WHEREAS, applicant in Exhibit A attached to the supplemental application filed October 5, 1917, reports notes payable representing capital expenditures aggregating \$370,046.69, and requests authority to use the proceeds of the \$70,000 of bonds to pay in part said notes; and

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING:-

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that MIDLAND COUNTIES PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION be, and it is hereby, granted authority to use the proceeds from the \$70,000 of bonds, to which reference is made above, to pay in part the notes listed in Exhibit A attached to the supplemental petition filed October 5, 1917.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 4369, dated June 2, 1917, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this second supplemental order.
