ORDER

STAR AUTO STAGE ASSOCIATION having applied to this Commission for a certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by it of an automobile passenger, freight and express transportation business between Turlock, Newman and intermediate points, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require the operation by the Star Auto Stage Association of an automobile passenger, freight and express business between Turlock, Newman and intermediate points;

PROVIDED that the authority herein granted shall not be assignable; and

PROVIDED FURTHER, that this order shall not become effective until said Star Auto Stage Association shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said Star Auto Stage Association has

filed herein certified copies of permits from the cities of
Turlock and Newman, and the County of Stanislaus, as provid-
ed in section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917.
