SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That Condition No. 3 of the original order in this matter (Decision No. 4760) be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

The existing crossing on the Southern Pacific Company's line between Montalvo and Oxnard, at Southern Pacific Company's Engineer's Station 31+86, shall be closed.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, That permission be and the same hereby is granted applicant to construct a highway at grade over a wye track of the Southern Pacific Company, at State Highway Commission's Engineering Station approximately 349, subject to the conditions set forth in the original order as modified herein.

The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation,

maintenance and protection of said highway as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
