SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that in accordance with the order heretofore made in this proceeding on October 20, 1917, Producers Gas & Fuel Company has filed a stipulation, duly authorized by its board of directors declaring that neither said company, its successors nor assigns, will ever claim before the Railroad Commission or any court or other public body a value for the rights and privileges granted in Ordinance No. 120 of the County of Kern, adopted April 6, 1917, and Ordinance No. 35 of the City of McKittrick, adopted April 3, 1917, in excess of the actual cost of acquiring said rights and privileges, which cost is stated to be \$373.50.
