ORDER

Wm. F. Whitcomb, having applied for a certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation of an automobile stage service as a common carrier of passengers between Wilmar and First and Rowan Streets, Belvedere, in Los Angeles County, and having filed with the Railroad Commission certified copies of permits issued by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles as required by Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917, and the Commission being duly advised and believing that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Wm. F. Whitcomb of an automobile stage line for the transportation of passengers between Wilmar and First and Rowan Streets, Belvedere, in the County of Los Angeles; provided, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured; and provided, further, that no vehicle

may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
