In the matter of the application of PACIFIC EMECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY for authority to construct at grade a turn-out in Sixteenth Street, between arlington Street and Second Avenue, in the City of Los Angeles, California.

ORDER-

PACIFIC EMECTRIC RATIONAY COMPANY, a corporation, naving on December 29, 1917, filled with the Commission an application for permission to construct at grade a turn-out in Sixteenth Street, between Arlington Street and Second Avenue, in the City of Los Angeles, California, as hereinafter indicated; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the construction of the turn-out has been ordered by the Board of Public Utilities of the City of Los Angeles; and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossing with said street, and that this application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED. That permission be hereby granted Pacific Electric Railway Company to construct at grade a turn-out in Sixteenth Street, between Arlington Street and Second Avenue. In the City of Los Angeles, California, as shown by the map attached to the application: said crossing to be constructed subject to the following conditions, viz.:

- (I) The entire expense of constructing the crossing, together with the cost of its maintenance thereafter in good and first-class condition, for the said and convenient use of the public, shall be borne by applicant.
- (2) Said crossing shall be constructed of a width and type to conform to that portion of the street to be crossed now graded, with grades of approach not exceeding four (4) per cent; shall be protected by a suitable crossing sign, and shall in every way be made ease for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.
- (3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
