Title Insurance and Trust Company, a corporation, having applied for authority to transfer to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angelez a certain public utility water system used to supply about fifty persons in the territory in the City of Los Angeles lying between Pico Street and Glencoe Avenue and easterly of Bertrami Avenue, the district being known as Pico Boulevard Tract, the conveyance to be made in accordance with the form of deed attached to the application in this proceeding and marked Exhibit "B", in which the property to be transferred is described as follows:

All water pipes, service connections, fittings, meters, appliances, appurtenances and extensions constituting and pertaining to the water distribution system owned by the Title Insurance and Trust Company, and used and operated by said Title Insurance and Trust Company for supplying water in the territory within the City of Los Angeles, lying between Pico Street and Glencoe Avenue am easterly of Bertrami Avenue, in that certain tract known as the Pico Boulevard Tract in the City of Los Angeles; and being more particularly described as Tract No. 1740, as per map thereof recorded in Book 21, pages 146 and 147 of Maps, Records of said County.

and the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles, having joined in the application and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted?

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be and the same hereby is granted, provided that the authority herein granted shall apply only to such conveyance of property as may be made on or before January 31st, 1918, and provided further that within ten days after the conveyance is made a copy of the deed of conveyance shall be filed with the Railroad Commission.
