O P I N I O N

This is an application on behalf of F. C. Joseph for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Fresno and Clovis and intermediate points.

A public hearing was set in this proceeding at the Court House at Fresno at 10.00 AM on Saturday, January 12, 1918, but neither the applicant nor any person representing him or appearing in favor of the application was present.
