O R D E R

A. B. Watson, doing business under the fictitious name of the Crown Stage Company, having filed application asking that the Railroad Commission declare that the public convenience and necessity require the operation by applicant of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Garden Grove and the junction with the established stage line of applicant operating between Santa Ana and Long Beach, and the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES, That public convenience and necessity require the operation by A. B. Watson, doing business under the fictitious name of the Crown Stage Comp-

any, of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Garden Grove and the junction with the established stage line of applicant now operating between Santa Ana and Long Beach; provided, that this declaration shall not become effective until the applicant herein shall have received a supplemental order herein reciting that certified copy of permit issued by the Board of Supervisors of Orange County has been issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917, and filed with this Commission; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be assigned or transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been procured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
