ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Centerville Water Company having applied to the Commission for authority to issue stock and pledge it to secure a loan, and a public hearing having been held thereon September 18th, <sup>1917.</sup> and it appearing that the proposed pledge was to be in addition to the issue of a note and mortgage covering applicant's public utility property and also the private property of its president, and it appearing that the issue and pledging of stock would provide no additional security to the lender, and applicant having promised at the hearing to procure a segregation of the loan between applicant's property and the private property of its president, but no further action in the matter having been taken by applicant or its president nor answer made to numerous letters of the Commission, and ample notice

of proposed dismissal having been given to applicant.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application be and it is hereby dismissed.
