SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

This Commission having, by order heretofore made in this proceeding on November 8, 1917, provided as follows:

"THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORN-IA HEREBY DECLARES, that public convenience and necessity require the operation by the San Diego and South Eastern Railway Company of the various motor busses and trucks hereinbefore referred to as common carriers of persons and property between Lakeside, Ramona, autoian and intermediate points; provided, that the rights and privileges herein granted shall not be transforred or assigned unless the Railroad Commission's written consent to such assignment or transfer shall first have been secured."

and the San Diego and South Eastern Railway Company having sold all of its property to San Diego and Arizona Railway ' Company in accordance with the authority granted by this Commission in Decision No. 4897, made on November 27, 1917, in Application No. 3328, and having now requested the consent of the Commission to the transfer of the rights and privileges

granted in the order heretofore made in this proceeding on November 8, 1917; and it appearing that the board of supervisors of San Diego County did, on January 21, 1918, consent to the assignment by San Diego and South Eastern Railway Company to San Diego and Arizone Railway Company "of the right and authority to operate passenger automobiles and freight auto trucks along a route between Lakeside and Julian by way of Ramona, and also by way of Descanse, "--

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that the consent of the Reilroad Commission is hereby given to the transfor, on or before March 31, 1918, by San Diego and South Eastern Railway Company to San Diego and Arizona Railway Company, of the rights and priviloges granted in the order of the Railroad Commission heretofore made in this proceeding on November 8, 1917.
